2016 Etna Rosso

James Suckling 95 pts

Gorgeous aromas of strawberries, lavender and assorted flowers follow through to a full body, with silky and polished tannins and a long and flavorful finish. Intensely mineral and focused. Drink or hold.

Wine Spectator 91 pts

A vibrant, medium-bodied red, with light, grippy tannins wrapped in a silky mesh of crushed raspberry and fig fruit. Accents of graphite, smoke and herb echo on the finish. Drink now through 2026.

Wine Enthusiast 89 pts

Fresh and refined, this offers aromas of crushed rock, underbrush, dark berry and culinary spice. It's lithely structured, with strawberry, red cherry, crushed herb and star anise. Drink through 2021.

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2017 Etna Rosso

Wine Spectator 91 pts

Pretty mulberry and raspberry fruit wraps around chalky tannins in this bright and aromatic, light- to medium-bodied red, accented by tea rose, sandalwood and smoky mineral accents that linger on the finish. Drink now through 2026.

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2015 Etna Rosso Moganazzi-Volta Sciara

Wine Spectator 89 pts

Grilled herb and smoke notes lace dried cranberry and mulberry fruit in this chewy, medium-bodied red. Firm finish. Best after 2020.

Wine Enthusiast 90 pts

Smooth and delicious, this opens with inviting scents of red berry, chopped Mediterranean herb and dark culinary spice. It's bright and focused, offering Marasca cherry, strawberry, star anise and white-pepper flavors. Firm, polished tannins and fresh acidity provide effortless support. Drink through 2025.

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2016 Etna Rosso Moganazzi-Volta Sciara

Vivid aromas of dried strawberries and cherries with some flowers, following through to a full body, very silky and creamy tannins and a long and flavorful finish. A savory undertone to the wine. Drink now or hold.

Wine Spectator 92 pts

This light- to medium-bodied red exudes exotic spice and incense notes, drawing you into the flavors of dried cherry, thyme and licorice. Fresh and chewy, with a long-lasting salty, mineral finish. Drink now through 2026.

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2015 Etna Rosso Pignatuni

Wine Spectator 92 pts

This opens with a beautiful nose of Earl Grey tea and incense, followed by a lovely, expansive range of raspberry coulis, dried marjoram and smoky mineral set in a graceful frame. Supple tannins firm the lasting finish. Drink now through 2028.

Wine Enthusiast 90 pts

Forest floor, grilled herb, eucalyptus and ground clove aromas lead the nose. The taut linear palate shows dried cherry, crushed sage and licorice alongside fine-grained tannins and a saline-like mineral note. A burst of orange peel closes the finish.

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2016 Etna Bianco

Wine Spectator 87 pts

A light, smoky underpinning is layered with poached pear and apple blossom flavors in this fresh, light- to medium-bodied white, with hints of preserved lemon and spice. Modest finish. Drink now.

Wine Enthusiast 88 pts

Aromas of toasted nut, brimstone and a whiff of pressed acacia lift out of the glass. The linear palate offers yellow apple, citrus zest and a hint of dried herb alongside vibrant acidity. A light saline note marks the close.

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2015 Etna Bianco Moganazzi-Volta Sciara

Wine Enthusiast 90 pts

Enticingly delicate, this has alluring scents of Spanish broom, citrus blossom, Mediterranean scrub and white stone fruit. It's ethereal yet savory, with pear, white-peach and lemon zest flavors balanced by vibrant acidity. A tangy saline note marks the close.

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2017 Etna Bianco Moganazzi-Volta Sciara

Wine Spectator 91 pts

Well-cut acidity defines this harmonious, light- to medium-bodied white, offering a creamy mix of poached peach, almond blossom and preserved lemon, with a tang of smoke-tinged mineral lingering on the finish. Drink now through 2024.

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
