## 2014 Barolo

### James Suckling 91 pts

Aromas of cherries, bark and black tea. Some dried strawberries and flowers, too. Medium to full body, round and silky tannins and a fresh finish. Drink or hold.

### Vinous 90 pts – Antonio Galloni

Carlo Revello's 2014 Barolo is a serious, potent wine. That is not entirely surprising, as some very good parcels inform this bottling, including Gattera, Ceretta and Conca. Readers should be prepared to cellar the 2014 for at least a year, to give the tannins time to soften. This expressive, impeccably balanced entry-level Barolo is one of the hidden gems of the vintage.

### Wine Spectator 92 pts

This hits all the right notes, displaying cherry, plum, leather, tobacco and tar flavors, backed by a vibrant structure. Not big, but intense and persistent, with a long finish. Best from 2022 through 2040. 1,250 cases made.

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## 2015 Barolo

### James Suckling 93 pts

A very fragrant and lightly tarry nose with abundant roses and a wealth of dried red cherries. The palate delivers an elegant and succulent impression with light red-cherry flavor and a smooth array of fine, ripe tannins. Good balance, too. Drink or hold.

### Vinous 92 pts- Antonio Galloni

Carlo Revello's straight Barolo is once again superb in 2015. Then again, the Barolo includes wine from Gattera, Conca and Gattera Revello previously bottled as vineyard- designated Barolo during years he worked alongside his brother at the family's Fratelli Revello estate. Pliant, creamy and wonderfully expressive, Carlo Revello's 2015 Barolo hits all the right spots. Don't miss it.

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## 2014 Barolo R.G.

### James Suckling 88 pts

A bit too lemony and that doesn't quite pair with the generous tannins. Wanders a bit at the finish, but there is still good substance. No rough edges. Drink now.

### Vinous 92+ pts – Antonio Galloni

The 2014 Barolo R.G. is a blend of fruit from Rocche dell'Annunziata and Giachini, two first-rate sites that are almost always bottled as single- vineyard Barolos. A rush of black cherry, plum, spice, menthol and lavender fills out the wine's ample frame in grand style. Although quite expressive today, the 2014 is endowed with big tannins that need time to soften. This powerful Barolo has a lot of potential.

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## 2015 Barolo R.G.

**James Suckling 96 pts**

Perfumed and so brilliant with dark berries, roses and other flowers. Love it. Full body and ultra-polished tannins with superb length and beauty. Drink in 2022.

**Vinous 93 pts- Antonio Galloni**

The 2015 Barolo R.G. is a blend of fruit from Rocche dell'Annunziata and Giachini. There is plenty of intensity in the glass, but the wine feels dense and overly heavy, especially within the context of la Morra Barolos. It will be interesting to see where things go in this newly-born estate as Carlo Revello.

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
