



**The harvest at Azienda Agricola Salvatore Molettieri**

**The winter was not excessively rainy and there was no snow. There was the right amount of rain. In May and in June the weather was good. There were some rains in August and this favoured the maturity of the grapes. In September the weather was good with a lot of sun. There were about ten days of rain in October, but this is normal for the time of the year and it did not create problems for the grapes.**

The grapes were beautiful and healthy. It was a good harvest. We work a lot in the vineyards so that we have very little problems with disease and the quality of our grapes is always good, vintage after vintage. The grape yield this year was slightly lower in comparison to the previous vintages. The Aglianico wines are still fermenting and the fermentation is proceeding well.....”
